His primary research interest is in exposure sciences, including the development of tools that better characterise chemical emissions and exposure for use in risk assessments. He is a member of the BIAC workgroup on exposure assessments, which organises, coordinates and collaborate industry participation into the OECD Exposure Assessment work programme. He currently leads an internal research activity to develop the science that underpins environmental risk assessments of cosmetic ingredients in China. He is actively engaging with scientists across Asia (research, workshops, training courses) to develop Unilever's internal framework for assessing environmental safety of chemicals used by the FMCG industry.
