



**Paul Carmichael** has over 20 years experience in Toxicology and Cancer Research, largely in the academic arena, before joining Unilever, from Imperial College London, in 2003. He has published over seventy research papers in peer-reviewed scientific journals and has served on numerous committees and working groups such as the UK Environmental Mutagen Society, British Toxicology Society and Transatlantic Think-tank for Toxicology. He was a past recipient of the Tadion-Rideal Prize for Molecular Medicine from The University of London and the Upjohn Cancer Investigator Award from the American Association for Cancer Research. He is a Fellow of the British Toxicology Society and the Society of Toxicology in the USA. His interests cover the safety evaluation and risk assessment of genotoxic agents and the development of new approaches for 'Toxicity Testing in the 21st Century'. He has a B.Sc. degree from the University of Surrey in Toxicology and a Ph.D. in Biochemistry from King's College. He is an Honorary Professor at both Peking University in China and at Lancaster University in the UK.
